The Maine 3-Railers Model Railroad Club is hosting a *Model Train & Classic Car Cruise-in* in Augusta on **Sunday, July 23rd** from **9:00 AM to 2:00 PM** in the Front Street parking lot directly behind Brian Inch’s *Model Rail Scenes* train shop at 227 Water Street. The parking lot is located behind the stores on Water Street overlooking the Kennebec River. Brian’s shop has a rear entrance that opens directly onto the parking lot. **In case of inclement weather, anyone wishing to sell trains & accessories may do so INSIDE.**

We will have an open-air tailgate (or trunk) swap meet so that we can visit, display and buy and sell trains tailgate-style... with hopefully, a sprinkling of antique, collector and special interest cars mixed in. In addition, Brian is offering the use of his shop for us to socialize, run some trains and use his facilities. For those of you who haven’t visited Brian’s shop, he has a couple of really nice operating layouts and lots of trains and accessories... it in itself is a must-see! Brian is well established as a premier model train layout builder.

The entrance to Front Street is located off Water Street in downtown Augusta next to the Olde Federal Building (a former Victorian era post office) at the foot of Winthrop Street opposite the tall Key Bank Building now used as state offices. As you drive down into the parking lot at the river’s edge, keep to the left and go to the end. Look for the canopy over the rear entrance to Brian’s shop at 227 Water Street marked “227 WATER STREET” as shown below.
